Kindergarten – 12th Grade Guidelines

- Kindergarten and First Grade: Students may dictate poems to a person if a student's writing skills are being developed.
 - Second-Twelfth Grades: These students must write their own poems.
- Co-Authors: You can have co-authors (two or more students at the same grade level) write a poem.
 - This will be judged along with their respective grade level single author entries.
- One entry per student however **students may submit BOTH an individual poem AND a co-author poem. Students may also submit a short story entry.**
 - **The poem TITLE and student GRADE level must be on the FRONT page** of the poem.
 - Student's name should **NOT** be on the poem, only the entry form.
 - Poems must be **double spaced** and **typed**, unless using an unusual format.
 - **NO ILLUSTRATIONS!**
 - Poems must be free of spelling, grammatical, and punctuation errors.
 - Poems will be judged according to: interest stimulated, response evoked, creativity and originality, conciseness of vocabulary creating an image, rhythm, and spelling - unless for effect and appearance.
 - One typed copy of the manuscript must be given to an EIRC officer OR mailed to the chairperson of the local poetry contest by the deadline.
 - **This copy will not be returned.**
 - Each student needs their own entry form attached to the poem, including co-authors.
 - Each poem submitted must have an entry form stapled to the back page with **all information filled out correctly**. Please include ALL parent names on the form. Please **type or print neatly with blue or black ink**. The entry form can be copied. Only poems typed and labeled correctly with all requested information will be considered for the state poetry contest!

Poetry entries must be *received* by **Thursday, February 1, 2024.**
